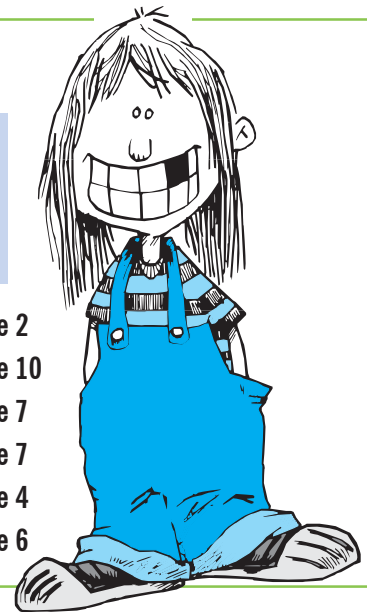

Is Invisalign for Me?

Step 1: Visit our office to see an Invisalign certified dentist.

During the initial visit, your orthodontist or dentist will evaluate, assess and discuss the course of treatment with you. Your doctor will take bite impressions of your teeth and will send these to Invisalign for processing.

Step 2: Invisalign makes your aligners.



Invisalign uses advanced 3-D computer imaging technology to transform your bite impressions into a custom-made series of clear and removable aligners. You will have the ability to view your computer modeling to see how your bite will be corrected.

Step 3: You receive your clear aligners in a few weeks.

During your next visit to your dentist, you will receive your first set of clear aligners. Your doctor will most likely give you a few additional sets to wear before your next visit. You'll wear each set of clear aligners day and night for about 2 weeks, removing them only to eat, drink, brush, and floss. Aligners are worn on average 22 hours a day. You'll visit your dentist at regular intervals to check your progress.
